RENT INCREASES 2023

(BEFORE July 6th, 2023)



Oregon has passed laws that impact renters. Here's what you need to know:

ALL RENT INCREASES REQUIRE 90 DAYS NOTICE.



RENT INCREASES received BEFORE 7/6/23



MONTH-TO-MONTH

If you've lived in your place less than 12 months.

NO INCREASES ARE ALLOWED!

FIXED TERM and MONTH-TO-MONTH

If you've lived in your place 12 months or more, the maximum rent increase you can get is 7%+ that year's average inflation (7.6%) in 2023 which is 14.6%.









EXEMPTION NOTICE!

If your building's first certificate of occupancy was issued less than 15 years ago, you can get a rent increase of any amount after 12 months of living there.

If you live in subsidized housing, there are special rules about rent increases. Check with your local housing authority or affordable housing provider for details.

If you live in Portland, and received a rent increase of 10% or more, you might be eligible for relocation money.

RENT INCREASES received AFTER 7/6/23



MONTH-TO-MONTH

If you've lived in your place less than 12 months.

NO INCREASES ARE ALLOWED!

FIXED TERM and MONTH-TO-MONTH

If you've lived in your place 12 months or more, the maximum rent increase you can get is 10% in 2023.









EXEMPTION NOTICE!

If your building's first certificate of occupancy was issued less than 15 years ago, you can get a rent increase of any amount after 12 months of living there.

If you live in subsidized housing, there are special rules about rent increases. Check with your local housing authority or affordable housing provider for details.

If you live in Portland, and received a rent increase of 10% or more, you might be eligible for relocation money.
